
The **Friends of Donald Park, Inc.** have a new Facebook page! They lost access to their old page and despite every attempt they have been unable to reclaim the page.

### SEED COLLECTION

Each year volunteers, staff, partners, and Operation Fresh Start participants collect and process native plant seed from prairie, savanna, wetland, and woodland ecosystems. The seed is worth approximately \$600,000 and is used to restore over 170 acres of park lands.







# **OUTDOOR STORY TIME**


Friday, October 15
