Youth (kindergarten – 8th grade) are invited to join us at Stewart Lake County Park **this Saturday** from 9:00 a.m. to Noon for a free Youth Fishing Event! Program participants will rotate to specific learning stations, including fish identification, anatomy, casting, safety, fisheries management, and knot tying.

The first 150 youth participants that check in will get to take home a **free fishing rod** (max of 2 rods per family) along with a small selection of tackle after they have completed all of the stations.







NORTH MENDOTA TRAIL OPENING

Thank you all for joining us for the official opening and ribbon cutting of the North Mendota Trail!

This nearly half-mile of new trail through Governor Nelson State Park completes a 4-mile segment of the North Mendota Trail that connects the Village of Waunakee and the Town of Westport. The 12-foot wide paved shared-use trail will help alleviate safety issues for bicyclists along Highway M and help the North Mendota Trail move closer to completion. Future phases will connect the trail to Mendota County Park and the City of Middleton.

BIRD AND NATURE ADVENTURE




