
NEW STORYWALK® IS UP!

PARK EXPANSION

Dane County Executive Joe Parisi announced Thursday that the county hopes to purchase 295 acres in the town of Berry would make the popular Indian Lake County Park the largest recreational park in the county. Parisi said the already popular park has seen an increase in visitors this year during the pandemic, and the purchase would allow the county to "enhance the park's year-round outdoor offerings."

The proposal still needs approval from the County Board. The board will vote on the potential purchase in coming weeks.

NEW EDUCATIONAL TRAIL




The Upper Sugar River Watershed Association has created a new watershed trail at Prairie Moraine County Park. You can explore the natural landscapes while learning about the environmental and








TRAIL CLOSED AT P. BRANCH
